Year 9 Curriculum Information Evening Thursday 26th January – 6-8pm

Over the coming weeks Year 9 students will be making their Key Stage 4 GCSE options choices, ahead of starting their study towards these in September 2022. To facilitate this process, we will be holding our Year 9 Curriculum Information Evening on **Thursday 26thth January** 2023; the event will run from 6pm-8pm. Please find enclosed a copy of the Key Stage 4 options booklet, which provides information on the options process and a summary of the courses available will be available to your child. The options booklet contains a QR code which, when scanned, will take you to the Key Stage 4 course guide on The Garibaldi School website. Here you can view detailed information about each of the subjects available. Alternatively, if you are unable to scan the QR code you can view the course guide by typing in the following URL:

The online guide is fully desktop, tablet and mobile compatible. If you are unable to access the internet from any device, a printed copy of the course information is available from the school upon request.

In addition to the information contained in the options booklet and through the course guide, I would also like to draw your attention to the English Baccalaureate. This is not a qualification in its own right but is a combination of subjects including English, Maths, Science, a humanities subject (History or Geography) and a language (Spanish) that offer an important range of knowledge and skills to young people.

While your child may not have decided on their future career path yet, attaining the EBacc at GCSE gives them access to a full range of employment options when they leave secondary school and the broad knowledge that employers are looking for. If they are thinking of going to university, the EBacc is also recommended by Britain's most prestigious universities.

A printed copy of the Options Choices form is available upon request. Options Choices forms need to be submitted by Friday 17th March 2022. Where forms are not returned by this deadline, students may have options allocated to them. Up to this deadline an updated form could be submitted if required. Please note subject specifications are subject to change and the provision of option subjects is dependent on viable numbers of students opting for them.

Year 9 Parents' Evening will be held on Wednesday 22nd February. This event gives a further opportunity to ask any final questions relating to the options process or course suitability before the deadline date arrives for handing in options forms. Further correspondence will be sent with details of the parents' evening in the near future.
