Mr West, Director of Sixth Form and Miss Hadley, Sixth Form Manager, will be on site to speak to and to support specifically with university offers and places and if required the clearing process.

Year 13 students who have applied through UCAS will receive correspondence from UCAS on the morning of the 18th August, which will possibly give them an indication of their results before they collect them from the school.
