Year 7 and 8 Remote Working Guidance

Dear Parents/Carers

In light of the government's decision to close schools to the majority of students for the foreseeable future we will be setting work for students to do remotely. For Year 7 and 8 we'll be setting project or learning pack based work.

- These will be extended pieces of work which should take around 10 hours to complete.
- These will be posted on the website for students to download and work on.
- Each week work will be set for one of the Core and one of the non-Core subjects 20 hours
 of work in total
- Work will be differentiated for students to be suitable for their ability group.
- The first of these projects / learning packs will be issued for w/c 23rd March. These will be updated weekly on the Monday of each week.
