

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our support for students in the run up to the exam season, Year 11 have a range of revision sessions available to them over the May half term break; please see the attached timetable for details. Morning sessions run from 9.00 to 11:30 and afternoon sessions from 12:00 to 14:30 – unless indicated otherwise.

- Students should arrive on site for morning sessions from 8.45 and no later than 08.55 and for afternoon sessions from 11.45 and no later than 11.55. Teachers delivering sessions will meet students in the Main Hall and then escort them over to the rooms they are using.
- Please note additional details for the relevance of particular sessions. For example, Maths sessions are focused on particular tiers of entry.
- Students need not wear school uniform but they should bring their normal school equipment and any revision materials that they feel may be useful. If relevant, subject areas will share details of specific resources required.
- Food won't be available at lunch time, however if students have the opportunity to and want to stay for both a morning and afternoon session on any day they can bring a packed lunch.
- The revision sessions will be specifically planned to support identified areas of support highlighted by the recent mock exams. They will be focused and tightly paced. As such the same expectations for engagement and conduct will apply as in any normal school day.
