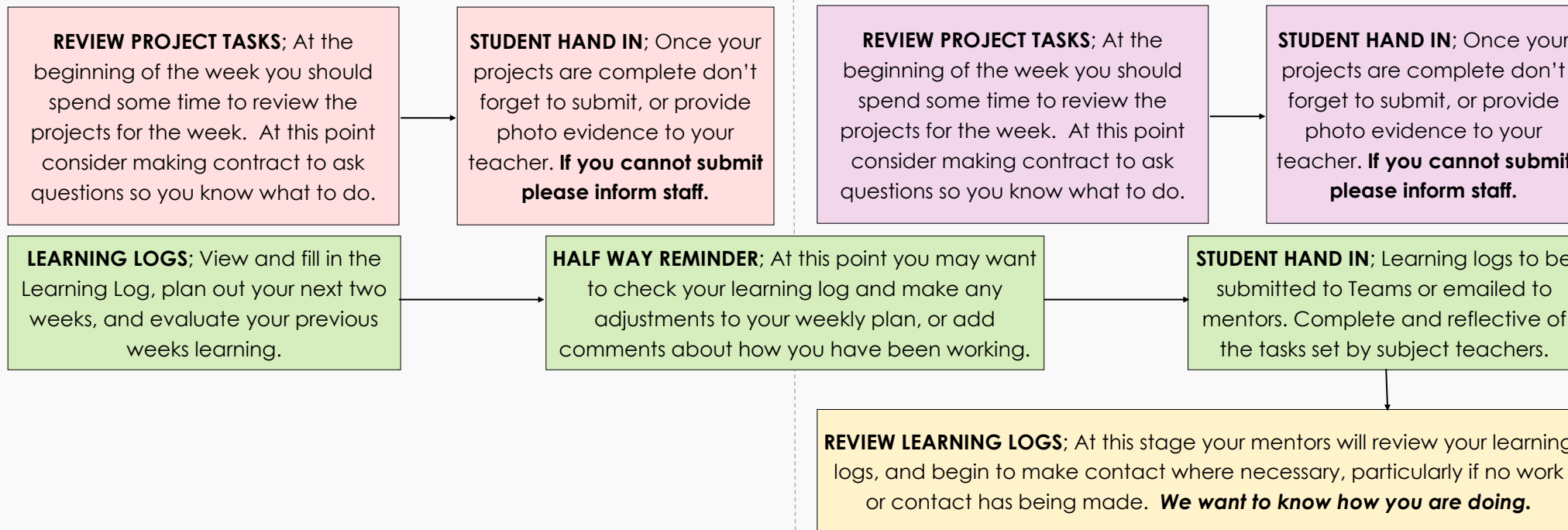


REMOTE WORKING YR8
