



Each column is over 22 metres high. That's the height of just over 5 and ½ double decker buses.

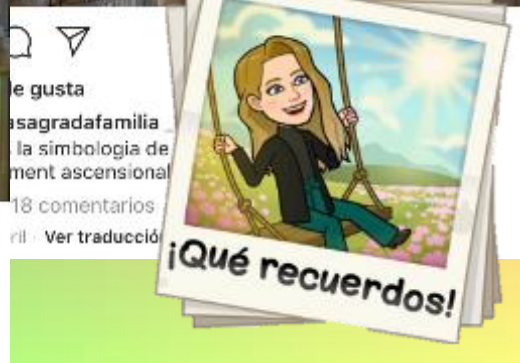


There are a total of 36 columns, made of different materials, and this gives them a variety of colours. Each one has a meaning. The four pillars in the centre of the transept are dedicated to the Evangelists, whose symbols can be seen on the lamps. When the natural light begins to fade, these lamps illuminate the inside of the church with a very colourful light.

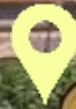

Catalonia is an autonomous community on the northeastern corner of Spain, designated as a nationality by its Statute of Autonomy. Catalonia consists of four provinces: Barcelona, Girona, Lleida, and Tarragona. The capital and largest city is Barcelona, the second-most populated municipality in Spain and the core of the fifth most populous urban area in the European Union.
